Large village and community on the island of Anglesey in Wales, situated on the Menai Strait next to the Britannia Bridge and across the strait from Bangor. This village has the longest place name in Europe and one of the longest place names in the world. The short form of the village's name is *Llanfairpwllgwyngyll*, also spelled *Llanfair Pwllgwyngyll*. It is commonly known as *Llanfair PG* or *Llanfairpwll*. The approximate pronunciation in English orthography is given at the station as:
Llan-vire-pooll-guin-gill-go-ger-u-chwurn-drob-ooll-llantus-ilio-gogo-goch.
