Unusual Clothing

Before class, make one copy of the worksheet for each group of three or four students.

Procedure

Divide the class into small groups of three or four. Give each group a copy of the worksheet.

Tell them that the twenty words are all unusual articles of clothing, and that they must decide if each one is worn above or below the belt (i.e. the waist).

Tell the groups they have five minutes and start them all at the same time.

When the time limit is up, get the groups to exchange papers for marking, and check the answers orally.

Ask each team to read out their score. The team with the highest score is the winner.

Answer Key

Worn above the belt:

blouse, brooch, collar, cravat, cufflinks, hoody, mittens, poncho, shawl, tiara, waistcoat

Worn below the belt:

clogs, flip-flops, kilt, leggings, slippers, sarong, tights, trainers, trunks
