Don't buy two things in the same shop.

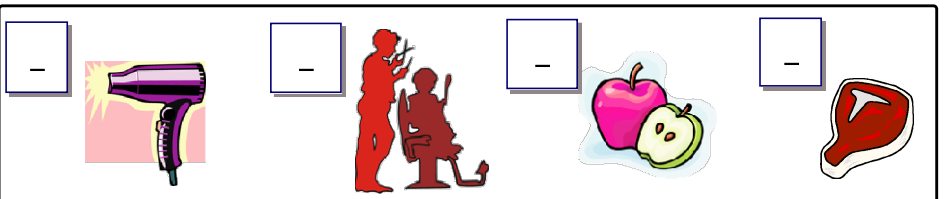
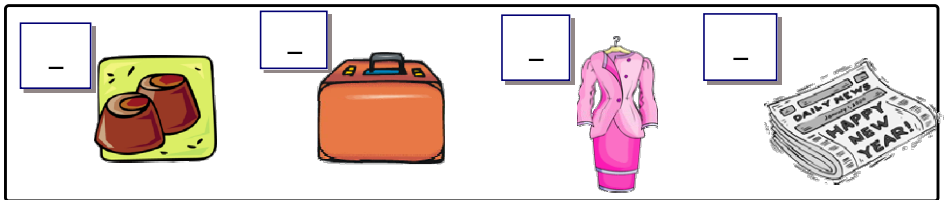
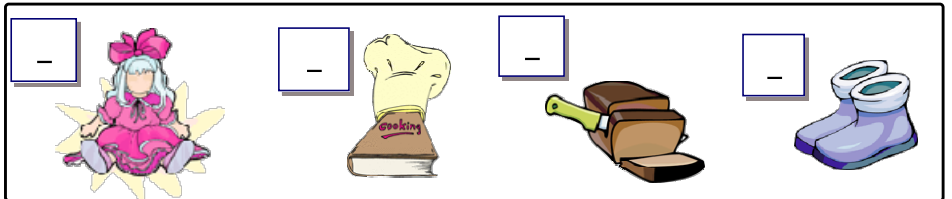
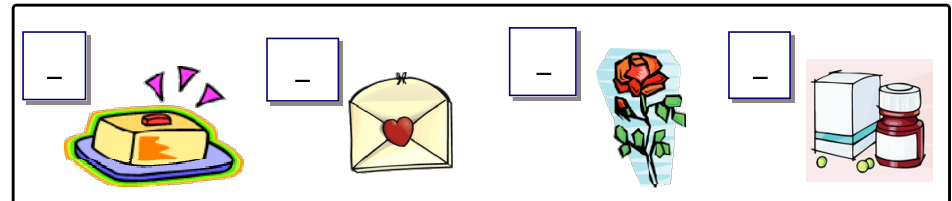
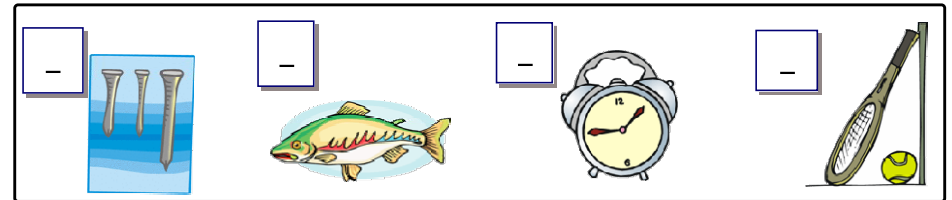
Of course, you should ask polite questions :
